AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC* OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL PARKING, SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY, AND STOP INTERSECTION REGULATIONS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH; REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND CONTAINING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Borough Code to enact certain regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the community of the Borough of Conshohocken;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the Borough Code to enact certain regulations concerning the movement of vehicles and traffic in and through the Borough;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken has established, *inter alia*, regulations relating to the parking of vehicles within the Borough of Conshohocken at Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* of the Code of the Borough of Conshohocken; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken desires to amend Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* to establish additional no parking, snow and ice emergency, and stop intersection regulations in certain areas of the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 15 Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2 Traffic Regulations, § 15-213 Stop Intersection Established is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

Stop Street	Intersection or Through Street	Direction of Travel
East Elm Street	Jones Street	East

SECTION 2.

Chapter 15 Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4 General Parking Regulations, § 15-402 Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	Between
East 8th Avenue	North	From "no parking" signage east to intersection with Harry Street
West 5th Avenue	South	From western edge of driveway to parking lot for Borough Police Department to western edge of driveway to parking lot for Borough Administrative Offices (distance of 35 feet)

SECTION 3.

Chapter 15 Vehicles and Traffic, Part 4 General Parking Regulations, § 15-406 Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited.

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	Location	Authorized Purpose of Vehicle
East 11th Avenue	North	Area in front of 20 East 11th Avenue	Patient Parking Only During the Hours of M-F, 7 AM-7 PM

SECTION 4.

Chapter 15 Vehicles and Traffic, Part 9 Snow and Ice Emergency, § 15-903 Snow Emergency Routes Designated is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	Direction of Travel
East First Avenue (north side)	Harry Street to Fayette Street	West
West First Avenue (north side)	Fayette Street to Forrest Street	West

SECTION 5.

Any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in violation or in conflict with the terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such irreconcilable conflict.

SECTION 6.

The terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and, should any portion, part or provision of this ordinance be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, non-enforceable or unconstitutional, the Council hereby declares its intent that the ordinance shall have been enacted without regard to the invalid, non-enforceable, or unconstitutional portion, part or provision of this ordinance.

SECTION 7.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
